- 5. Motion to permit Bp. Paul Hewett to represent FACA as a part of the upcoming delegation to the Archbishop of Athens in October 2014. Moved by Bp. William Millsaps; seconded by Bp. Walter Grundorf. All in favor.

There were three positive outcomes from the April meeting:

- Joint Synods possible by the summer of 2016 for all FACA jurisdictions and members so that the laity and clergy get to know each other.
- Spring of 2015, a Congress of all Anglo-Catholic bishops of the world, to include of course all clergy and laity who can attend hosted by St. Andrew's, Diocese of Forth Worth for all ecumenical partners, Orthodox, Polish National Catholic, Union of Scranton, Roman and traditional Lutheran.

- The Union of Scranton is now comprised of the Polish National Catholic Church based in Scranton, Pennsylvania, and the Nordic Catholic Church, based in Oslo, Norway. The Free Church of England is seeking to come under this umbrella, as is the REC work in Europe. The Diocese of the Holy Cross has been invited to look into this as well.
